14th Vienna Future Dialogue 2017
Vienna, 06 November 2017

Tomorrow starts today. Digitisation is an essential prerequisite for the continuous growth of the global economy. The trend in the development of the software industry arouses interest among many investors. High-ranking representatives from business and politics from 38 countries discussed the necessity of cooperation under the motto "Economy meets politics".

Many concrete projects, ideas and perspectives were discussed at the conference. Regional economic cooperation in the Western Balkans as a basis for the stability and prosperity of the whole region and of Europe as a whole is an important prerequisite for the EU integration process. Vice-President of the OWWF, Mr. Hermann Pönisch, underlined the importance of transnational cooperation between Austria and Bavaria.
