

Short biography

Dr Ergün Özsoy was born in Turkey and completed his school education in Ordu, Eskişehir and Ankara. He graduated from Hasanoğlan Atatürk Anatolian High School and completed his Bachelor's degree in Turkish Language and Literature at the Faculty of Education, Gazi University.

Dr Özsoy completed his Master's degree in Mediterranean Studies at Istanbul University with a thesis on "The Mediterranean in 16th Century German Travelogues". He wrote his doctoral thesis entitled "Ottomans and Habsburgs: 1550-1560: Politics-Economy-Culture" at Istanbul University.

His research interests include the development of Turkish-German relations in the early modern period, German travelogues about Turkey and Turkish language teaching from the Middle Ages to the present. Dr Özsoy publishes articles in Turkish, German and English and regularly participates in academic conferences in various countries, especially Turkey and Germany.

After working at Ankara University for 20 years, Dr Özsoy moved to Germany with his family in 2013. He currently teaches courses on Turkish language and culture as well as on the common history of Turks and Germans at the University of Augsburg and the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich. He lives in Augsburg and spends a lot of time in Turkey.
